

## Snowman Hand-y Craft

Winter is the perfect time to play in the snow. Whether you live in a climate where there is snow or not, you can create your own snowman.

### Materials Needed:

- ❖ old white sock, nylons or tights
- ❖ one bag of cotton balls
- ❖ 3 small rubber bands
- ❖ 1 sheet of felt (any color)
- ❖ 2 craft google eyes
- ❖ 4 inches of ribbon
- ❖ 1 black pipe cleaner
- ❖ one piece candy corn
- ❖ black permanent marker
- ❖ glue
- ❖ scissors



### Time to Create!

**Step 1:** If using nylons or tights, cut off one of the legs. Stuff the toe with cotton balls to create the head (about 2-3 inches in diameter).



**Step 2:** Tie off with a rubber band.

**Step 3:** Continue to stuff the sock to create the middle of the snowman (about 4-5 inches in diameter).


**Step 4:** Tie off with a rubber band.

**Step 5:** Continue to stuff the sock to create the bottom of the snowman (about 6-7 inches in diameter).

**Step 6:** Draw a line of dots on the bottom of the head to create a mouth.

**Step 7:** Glue candy corn above the mouth for the nose.

**Step 8:** Glue on the google eyes.





**Step 9:** Cut the felt into a 4 x 8 inch rectangle for the hat. Cut ½ inch slits across the top of the 4 x 8 inch rectangle to make fringe.

**Step 10:** Cut a 9 x ½ inch strip for the scarf. Cut two ½ inch slits on each end of the scarf to make fringe.

**Step 11:** Glue the 4-inch edges of the 4 x 8 inch rectangle together to create the hat.

**Step 12:** Tie the ribbon just below the fringe.

**Step 13:** Cut the pipe cleaner in half, then cut 1 inch off of each of the pieces.



**Step 14:** Glue the hat onto the top of the head.

**Step 15:** Twist one of the 1 inch pipe cleaners around one of the long pipe cleaners, ½ inch from the end to create the arm. Then repeat for the second arm.

**Step 16:** Cut small slits into the sides of the middle section of the snowman. Glue the arms into each of the slits.
