

Mother's Day Crown Hand-y Craft

Mother's Day is a great time to make your mother a queen with this crown creates with your hands.

Materials Needed:

- 2-3 pieces of cards stock
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue
- Crayons or Markers
- Craft Jewels



Time to Create!

Step 1: Trace one hand for each child in the family for large families. Trace both hands for each child in small families.



Step 2: Decorate your traced hands with Crayons, Markers and Jewels.

Step 3: Cut one of the pieces of paper into 3 – strips that are 11 inches long by 2 inches strips wide.

Step 4: Glue the three strips together end to end.



Step 5: Glue the decorated hands on top of the strips. If you have an odd number of hands, glue the largest hand centered on the strip (as shown in the picture to the left). If you have an even number of hands, glue the two largest hands with one on each side of the center point of the strip. Finish gluing the small hands on the left and right sides of the larger hands.

Step 6: Glue the two end of the strip together to create the crown. (You will want the crown to be between 19 – 24 inches in diameter to fit on you mothers head. You may want to measure.)

Step 7: Present the crown to your Mother on Mother's Day.
